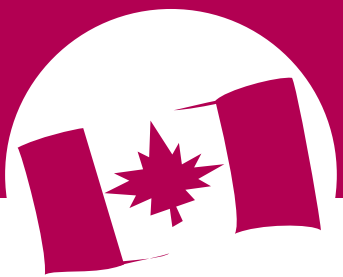

## CANADA DAY CELEBRATION



### INSTRUCTION SHEET

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

A school-wide “fun day”; typically done as a wrap-up to a unit on Canada. Works well the last day before the long weekend.

Each instructor is responsible for 1 multi-level activity, such as a warm-up Shoe Salad, Treasure Hunt, grass Hockey Game, Nature Walk, O Canada Singing Competition, Cake Decorating, etc. Half the activities are for the morning, the other after a potluck lunch. Students are divided into teams for the day as they rotate through each set of morning and afternoon activities.

**REQUIRED STRUCTURES:** imperatives, future tenses (for planning)

**REQUIRED VOCABULARY:** any from Treasure Hunt or Nature Walk hand-outs

**GROUP SIZE:** whole school

**HANDOUTS:** words to O Canada, Treasure Hunt list, Nature Walk guide (picture dictionary) potluck contribution card (name of food, country of origin, ingredients)

**OTHER MATERIALS REQUIRED:** group nametags, waiver forms, schedule, (map of park), plain sheet cakes, coloured icing (for cake decorating activity), hockey sticks, hockey ball, others as per chosen activities.
