



# INFORMATION ABOUT B.C. NATURAL FEATURES CARDS: Pictionary

## INSTRUCTION SHEET

### INSTRUCTIONS:

The same cards from the introductory matching cards can be used to play a game of “Pictionary” once students are more confident with the vocabulary of the unit. The class is divided into small groups for teams, with individual members of the groups taking turns drawing for their team. Using only the vocabulary cards (not the picture cards), the “drawer” pulls a vocabulary card and must illustrate on the drawing surface for his/her team to guess the natural feature. Whichever team’s member guesses the feature, that team gets the point.

### REQUIRED STRUCTURES:

**REQUIRED VOCABULARY:** *ocean, lake, river, mountains, glacier, island, forest, highway, city, town, railway*

**GROUP SIZE:** whole class divided into small groups

**HANDOUTS:** Natural Features Vocabulary cards, cut into individual cards

**OTHER MATERIALS REQUIRED:** large drawing surface (chart paper, chalkboard, whiteboard) with appropriate pens, scoreboard, timer
