FIND SOMEONE WHO...

INSTRUCTION SHEET

INSTRUCTIONS:

A “mixer” activity for students to find out more about their classmates and practise Yes-No questions. After reviewing Yes-No question structure, each student is given a copy of the worksheet. Students are to fill in the blanks with the names of the classmates who can answer “Yes, I do/ Yes, I can/ Yes, I have” to those questions. Encourage the students to have as many different names on their papers as possible, so they are speaking to all classmates.

REQUIRED STRUCTURES: Yes-No questions, asking for details/more information

REQUIRED VOCABULARY: *golf, birdwatching, meet people, hobby, knit, sing, choir, play..musical instrument, walks, team sport, library card*

GROUP SIZE: whole class

HANDOUTS: Find Someone Who... worksheet (one per student)

OTHER MATERIALS REQUIRED: none

RELATED GRAMMAR: activities (nouns) as verbs, gerunds and infinitives following “like”

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES:

Ask the students who do the activities listed to share how they got interested/involved in the activity, how often they participate, and how other classmates could join them.
