INSTRUCTION SHEET

INSTRUCTIONS:

A blank template of a monthly calendar has been made for the class to fill in on a monthly basis. Begin with a dictation of what day the first of the month is, then tell students what other statutory holidays and school events are happening in the coming month. Elicit birthdays and cultural holidays from the students, then, depending on the level, have students check the local newspaper listings or radio station's community events listings. Keeping a copy of the calendar on the wall of your classroom allows it to be updated as more information is available, and ensures access to anybody wishing to participate in community events.

**note the calendar has been made in the Latin American format to have Saturdays and Sundays together, as splitting weekend events may confuse students as to when events are held.

REQUIRED STRUCTURES: ordinals for dates

REQUIRED VOCABULARY: days and dates, holidays and celebrations

GROUP SIZE: whole class

HANDOUTS: blank calendar template (enlarged to 11"x17" for classroom display)

OTHER MATERIALS REQUIRED: community newspaper listings, Multi-Faith Calendar, etc.

RELATED GRAMMAR: adverbs of frequency "every ..., once a month, every second ..."; etc.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES:

Students may be assigned getting more information about an upcoming event or researching the background of a holiday or celebration
